WHEREAS, the people of Alabama recognize the importance of developing citizens of character to propagate our democratic institutions and the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, in 1995, Alabama became the second state in the Union to adopt a modern character education mandate (Act 95-313), which requires the teaching and promoting of character principles each day to make public schools safer; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama character education mandate improves school climates by fostering respectful and responsible behavior; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 "Alabama, A State of Character" joint resolution appeals for all stakeholders to collaborate in developing and supporting the implementation of character-building strategies for use in communities across Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Alabama will participate in the third annual Alabama Character Education Day activities on September 26, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim September 26, 2018, as

Character Education Day
