



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS I proclaimed a State of Emergency in the State of Alabama effective at 3:00 p.m. CDT on October 8, 2018, in anticipation of Hurricane Michael;

WHEREAS the damage caused by Hurricane Michael required substantial emergency response and recovery efforts by state employees, including by many state employees who were required to travel away from their home base of operation to carry out such efforts;

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2018, I issued a supplemental proclamation ordering that such state employees be reimbursed for the actual expenses they incur while performing these services on behalf of the State of Alabama; and


WHEREAS the efforts to respond to Hurricane Michael will continue for the foreseeable future and will specifically require the services of state employees who must travel away from their home base of operations to participate in those efforts;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, pursuant to the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, as amended, *see* Ala. Code § 31-9-8, and other applicable law, do hereby proclaim the existence of conditions that warrant a 60-day extension of the State of Emergency I proclaimed on October 11, 2018. For the duration of this 60-day extension, I authorize and direct the reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses, as prescribed by the Fiscal Policies and Procedures Manual, for state employees who have been, are being, or may be called to service away from their home base during this State of Emergency. In all other respects, the State of Emergency proclaimed on October 11, 2018, is hereby declared terminated, and affected state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.

FURTHER, I declare that this Proclamation shall be retroactive to December 7, 2018, so that it will remain in full force and effect until February 5, 2019, unless otherwise terminated or extended by proclamation of the Governor.
