

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, more than 16 percent of Alabamians of all ages have disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Alabama's disability community has a critical interest in policies enacted at local, state and national level that affect the meaningful integration of people with disabilities into their communities; and

WHEREAS, voting is one of our nation's most fundamental rights, a hallmark of our democracy and a key way in which we engage in civics; and

WHEREAS, many people with disabilities risk exclusion from this fundamental right of citizenship because of prejudicial assumptions about their capabilities or barriers affecting their access to the electoral process;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim July 15th through July 19th, 2019, as

Disability Voter Registration Week

in the state of Alabama.
