

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, home health and safety hazards, including physical safety hazards, lead-based paint, radon, mold, pests, and allergens, cause or contribute to a wide range of illnesses and diseases, including lead poisoning, asthma, cancer and injuries; and

WHEREAS, lead poisoning affects thousands of Alabama's children under six; and

WHEREAS, accidents in the home hurt thousands of people every year, and

WHEREAS, hundreds of Alabama's children die from chemicals stored and used improperly in the home; and

WHEREAS, dozens of people in Alabama die from carbon monoxide poisoning every year; and

WHEREAS, many Alabama families and households are unaware that their homes can have serious health hazards; and

WHEREAS, education and awareness about the dangers of unhealthy or unsafe housing can save Alabamians;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim June 2019, as

Alabama Healthy Homes Month

in the state of Alabama.
