WHEREAS, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Alabama (RMHC Alabama) opened its first house in Birmingham, Alabama on June 1, 1979 to provide a haven for families of sick and injured children; and

WHEREAS, since its founding forty years ago, RMHC Alabama has served more than 40,000 families. They help families with sick children by keeping them close to each other and by providing medical care for those children; and

WHEREAS, RMHC Alabama has remained dedicated to nurturing the health and well-being of children and families through its programs not only to provide access to quality health care, but also to enable family-centered care, which ensures families are fully supported and actively involved in their children's care; and
