

PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, authenticated information has reached this office regarding the need to increase a reward offered on March 20, 2017 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murders of Frank James Hill and Antoni Markee Means in Lowndes County, Alabama;

WHEREAS, it appears that the double homicide remains unsolved.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama, under §15-9-1, Code of Alabama, 1975, do hereby issue this proclamation, increasing the existing reward to a total of \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) found guilty of a crime enumerated in §15-9-1, Code of Alabama, 1975, provided there has no arrest of same at the time of issuance of this proclamation, and entitlement to this reward shall include only private citizens and shall not include members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or their blood relatives.
