

STATE OF ALABAMA PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding an apparent double homicide in Butler County, Alabama, on or about October 24, 2017;

WHEREAS Javon Cortez Banks and Ladarious Devante Lymon suffered fatal gunshot wounds as they sat in a vehicle on Airport Road outside the City of Greenville;

WHEREAS the case remains unsolved and there are no suspects; and,

WHEREAS the circumstances surrounding this event indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator or perpetrators.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under Ala. Code § 15-9-1 (1975), do hereby offer a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest <u>and</u> conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this double murder as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
