By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, nearly 356,989 of Alabama's elementary and secondary students are transported to and from school each day of the school year; and

WHEREAS, the safety of these students is of utmost importance to all citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS, Alabama's school bus drivers and other transportation employees work diligently to ensure safe transportation for all Alabama students; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama State Board of Education calls on every citizen of Alabama to make every week a safe one for the students and school buses of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim October 21-25, as

School Bus Safety Week

in the state of Alabama and urge all Alabamians, particularly motorists, to be especially cautious where school buses and school children are involved.
