By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, cleaning is an investment in improving human health and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Worldwide Cleaning Industry Association found cleanliness can reduce the probability of infection from the common cold and influenza by approximately 80%, as well as the number of surfaces contaminated by viruses by 62%; and

WHEREAS, improved cleanliness increases worker productivity by 5%, student productivity by 2-8%, as well as customer and worker satisfaction; and


