

## Proclamation

## By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, the Porsche Track Experience, the Official U.S. Driving School of Porsche, has been operating in the United States for twenty years; and

WHEREAS, for seventeen of its twenty years, the U.S. Porsche Track Experience has been located in the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the Porsche Track Experience, located at the Barber Motorsports Park in Birmingham, Alabama is one of only sixteen such Porsche schools in the world; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama-based school is the school for the entire United States; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama-based Porsche Track Experience is the largest such school in the world, being thirty percent larger than the school in Germany; and

WHEREAS, since its location in Alabama, more than 30,000 people have attended the school, with more than ninety-two percent of them coming from out-of-state; and

WHEREAS, the Porsche Track Experience has generated much positive publicity for the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the Porsche Track Experience has generated the usage of tens of thousands of hotel rooms and has produced numerous other economic benefits to the State of Alabama;
