WHEREAS, concerned Americans are determined to prevent these tragedies by observing Workers Memorial Day on April 28,2020 as a day to remember these victims of workplace injuries and diseases; and

WHEREAS, renewing our efforts to seek stronger safety and health protections, better standards and enforcement, and fair and just compensation is essential to addressing this common issue;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim April 28, 2020, as
