

STATE OF ALABAMA PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding the unsolved attempted murder of Curtis Michael Henchel and his family in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama on October 9, 2020;

WHEREAS Mr. Henchel was shot while driving southbound on I-20/59 near mile marker 96 in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama;

WHEREAS multiple bullets struck the vehicle he was driving, narrowly missing his wife and two young children;

WHEREAS Mr. Henchel is now paralyzed as a result of the injuries he sustained;

WHEREAS the attempted murder remains unsolved and there are no suspects at this time; and

WHEREAS the circumstances surrounding this crime indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator or perpetrators;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under Ala. Code § 15-9-3 (1975), do hereby offer a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this attempted murder as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
