WHEREAS, Local Quilt Shop Day is an annual arts celebration that was created to raise awareness about the importance of independent quilt shops to local economies; and

WHEREAS, the great State of Alabama is home to over 37 Local Quilt Shops; and

WHEREAS, as the demand for face coverings became apparent during the COVID-19 pandemic, many quilters seamstresses spent countless hours creating tens of thousands of face masks to protect healthcare and front-line workers; and

WHEREAS, local quilt shops embody the beating heart of sewing communities worldwide; and

WHEREAS, without local quilt stores, the rich character and even the history of our communities would be forever altered;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim January 23, 2021, as

Local Quilt Shop Day
