By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, the Text 2 Regret initiative is actively dedicated to educating young Alabamians about the repercussions of sexting and the importance of internet safety; and

WHEREAS, the National Center for Education Statistics reports that 94% of students have access to the internet in their homes and 65% have access to the internet at school; and

WHEREAS, the significance of teaching students in Alabama about internet safety should be at the forefront of the state's educational mission both at home and school; and

WHEREAS, it is crucial that Alabamians are aware of the Text 2 Regret initiative and are diligently using it to make the internet safer for students across the state; and

WHEREAS, it is encouraged that the Text 2 Regret initiative is used to reach an increased number of students in Alabama and to bring credibility to the principal of internet safety;
