## By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, sterile processing professionals are responsible for processing surgical instruments, supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, serving in settings ranging from hospitals to ambulatory surgical centers, Sterile Processing professionals provide support to patient care services; and

WHEREAS, sterile processing department tasks include decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembling, sterilizing, storing and distributing the medical devices and supplies needed for patient care; and

WHEREAS, the sterile processing department of a healthcare facility is the heart of all activity surrounding instruments, supplies and equipment required for operating rooms, endoscopy suites, intensive care units, birth centers and other patient care areas; and

WHEREAS, sterile processing professionals play a most important role in patient care arenas, and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections; and

WHEREAS, sterile processing week recognizes the contribution sterile processing professionals make to patient safety and the opportunities and challenges facing the profession;
