

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, the peanut industry contributes \$211.4 million yearly to the economy of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 900 farm families who grow peanuts on 183,000 acres in 33 counties across the state; and

WHEREAS, Alabama ranks second in the nation in peanut production, and the majority of the peanuts grown in the state are used to make peanut butter; and

WHEREAS, at 7 grams per one ounce serving of shelled peanuts, the peanut offers more protein than any nut; and

WHEREAS, it only takes 3.2 ounces of water to grow one ounce of shelled peanuts, which is less than any nut;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim March 2022, as

Peanut Month

in the state of Alabama and call upon our citizens to join in this special observation by purchasing and eating more peanuts, peanut butter and other delicious peanut products.
