By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, women own nearly 13 million businesses in the United States, employing more than 9.4 million workers. Their businesses generated more than \$1.9 trillion dollars in revenue as of 2019; and

WHEREAS, from 2014 to 2019, the number of women-owned businesses climbed 21% to a total of nearly 13 million; and

WHEREAS, Alabama ranks 15^{th} in the nation for women owned businesses with a growth rate of 42%; and

WHEREAS, Alabama has an estimated 154,000 women-owned businesses, employing just over 111,000 people with combined sales of \$19 billion; and

WHEREAS, March is recognized as Women's History Month, and Alabama is proud to recognize our long line of female trailblazers; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alabama values entrepreneurial businesses and seeks to celebrate growth in business ownership among women in the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim March 30, 2022, as

Women-Owned Business Day

in the state of Alabama.
