By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, only 30 of military family respondents to the 2021 Military Family Lifestyle Survey reported that they feel a sense of belonging to their local civilian community, and a sense of belonging is essential to the wellbeing and readiness of military families; and

WHEREAS, Blue Star Welcome Week (BSWW) is a nationwide campaign hosted by Blue Star Families. It builds a sense of belonging for service members, transitioning veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, Alabama commits to ensuring that military and veteran-connected families feel a strong sense of belonging to their local civilian communities; and

WHEREAS, we express gratitude for the sacrifices made by service members, transitioning veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, we encourage Alabamians and civilians nationwide to welcome military and veteran-connected families into their communities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim September 24 through October 2, 2022, as
