

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, Alabama recognizes the importance of providing children and youth with permanent, safe and loving families through adoption; and

WHEREAS, approximately 5,700 children and youth are in the custody of the Alabama Department of Human Resources; and

WHEREAS, approximately 70 percent of foster children and youth return to their biological families; and

WHEREAS, Alabama recognizes the diligence and hard work that adoption professionals display every day while identifying forever families for children and youth in foster care; and

WHEREAS, Alabama recognizes the valuable partnerships of many agencies and organizations that help make adoption possible for children and youth in foster care; and

WHEREAS, 342 foster children and youth are currently available for adoption in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, 223 of these children and youth do not yet have identified adoptive resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the Honorable Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim November 2022, as

National Adoption Month

in the state of Alabama.
