By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, school psychology has over 60 years of well established, widely recognized and highly effective practice and standards that are clearly articulated in National Association of School Psychologist's model for comprehensive and integrated school psychology services; and

WHEREAS, Alabamians should recognize the vital role that school psychologists and psychometrists play in the personal and academic development of our children;
