

STATE OF ALABAMA PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding the death of 39-year-old Melanie Amber Dorrill on October 4, 2022;

WHEREAS the victim was shot and killed before being discovered inside her Ariton residence in Coffee County, Alabama;

WHEREAS the circumstances surrounding this event indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the person or persons responsible for this crime.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under Ala. Code § 15-9-1 (1975), do hereby offer a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest <u>and</u> conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this event as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
