

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, regular cleaning and disinfection are an investment in human health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention stresses the importance of routine cleaning and disinfecting to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, according to the Worldwide Cleaning Industry Association, cleaned and disinfected surfaces reduce virus concentration by 41.7%, and when combined with hand hygiene, the concentration reduction increases to 85.4%; and

WHEREAS, nearly three in five people are more aware of surface cleanliness when they are out in the public, and over half say that they would be more likely to frequent a business if it provided evidence that their facility has been properly disinfected; and

WHEREAS, manufacturers and distributors produce and deliver crucial cleaning and hygiene products; and

WHEREAS, essential frontline cleaning professionals work tirelessly to keep our schools, hospitals, work places and other spaces healthy and safe for us all; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Alabama proudly support the cleaning industry and understand the importance of ensuring clean and sanitary conditions at work, in schools and at home;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim March 26 through April 1, 2023, as

Cleaning Week

in the state of Alabama.
