By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, Alabama is committed to pursuing public policies that strengthen the family and offer the greatest possible choice in education for the children; and

WHEREAS, Alabama recognizes the tremendous value and importance of parental involvement in the education of every student across our state; and

WHEREAS, since 1925, the Supreme Court has repeatedly recognized the fundamental constitutional rights of parents to direct the education and upbringing of their children; and

WHEREAS, children at home in Alabama and across America have consistently demonstrated the excellence of this model of education by attaining median score well above the average on academic achievement tests; and

WHEREAS, home education provides parents with the opportunity to cultivate and influence the faith and moral values of their children; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that Alabama recognizes and celebrates the contributions of homeschooling families, parents and children alike, to the quality of education found in the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim April 13, 2023, as

Home Education Day
