WHEREAS, half a million babies are admitted to the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) every year; and

WHEREAS, families of NICU babies may struggle to find resources, support and education; and

WHEREAS, funding for research into the causes of a NICU stay, as well as the holistic care of NICU families, is vital; and

WHEREAS, Alabama houses two institutions, Children's of Alabama and VAB Hospital, that provide the highest level of neonatal intensive care, medically acknowledged as Level IV NICU; and

WHEREAS, equipped with one of the largest pediatric kidney dialysis programs and the first to adapt the Aquadex Smartflow System for renal replace therapy in the United States, Children's of Alabama NICU is referred to patients by medical professionals for esteemed subspeciality and surgical care throughout the South; and


