RE: Flags Lowered Honoring Former Congressman Terry Everett

I am directing flags to be lowered to half-staff immediately on the grounds of the Alabama State Capitol Complex in Montgomery and in AL-02 to honor the service of former Congressman Terry Everett, who passed away on Tuesday, March 12, 2024.

Congressman Everett was elected to the 103rd and seven succeeding Congresses and retired in 2008. Prior to his service in Congress, he was a journalist, newspaper owner and publisher, and small businessman. He was also a veteran of the United States Air Force and a staunch supporter of southeast Alabama's military and farming communities.

The flags should be flown at half-staff for Congressman Terry Everett today until his interment, which will be announced at a later date.
