

STATE OF ALABAMA PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding the detonation of an explosive device outside the Alabama Attorney General's Office on February 24, 2024, in Montgomery County, Alabama;

WHEREAS no arrests have been made at this time; and

WHEREAS the circumstances surrounding this crime indicate that every effort should be made to protect the citizens of the State of Alabama by apprehending and convicting the perpetrator(s) of this act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under Ala. Code § 15-9-3 (1975), do hereby offer a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest <u>and</u> conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this crime as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or their relatives.
