WHEREAS, there is little awareness, no known cure and few effective treatment options or medications; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for more research, improved medications, additional treatment options, better support and hope for; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to those suffering from gastroparesis to educate the medical community and the public regarding the devastating effects of this disorder and promote awareness of the condition for the good of the public health;
