By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, incidences of latex allergy have increased due to widespread exposure to products containing latex rubber allergens; and

WHEREAS, latex allergies can be elicit by touching a product containing natural latex, breathing airborne latex protein particles, or digesting food prepared using latex gloves; and

WHEREAS, those who suffer from latex allergies commonly suffer from cross-reactive food allergies and/or asthma; and

WHEREAS, latex allergies can be prevented by avoiding all latex products which can be found in health care environments, restaurants, child care facilities, work places, schools, communities, and homes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim October 1-7, 2017, as

Latex Allergy Awareness Week

in the State of Alabama.
