WHEREAS, the alarming statistics related to at-risk-youth and teen-age delinquency compels us to focus on families and reinforce traditional family values on Parents' Day; and

WHEREAS, aware of the crisis of family breakdown throughout this nation, and that every moment counts in the efforts to respond to this emergency, we must address the importance of the sanctity of marriage in creating a home environment of peace and love. An emphasis on education to guide and nurture the next generation is also essential; and

WHEREAS, healthy and God-centered families are the foundation for healthy, well-adjusted nations, because the values that promote peace in the world are a direct extension of the values that promote peace within individual families; and

WHEREAS, God centered families and the pursuit of world peace are not two separate goals. Without families that embody the love and ideals of our creator, reconciliation and peace among divided classes, colors and creeds will remain an unattainable dream; and

WHEREAS, we encourage all parents, whether parental figures, step parents, adoptive parents or foster parents to commit themselves in creating a nurturing home environment that encourages sound development of their children as healthy, well-adjusted citizens of the community; and

WHEREAS, we support programs sponsored by federal, state and local faith based organizations or community groups that provide resources to help parents as they work hard to raise children of moral conviction and good character;
