

ProclamationBy the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of emergency responders is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our emergency responders is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who utilize the 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single, vital link for our emergency responders by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators of the State of Alabama have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, each telecommunicator has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim April 8^{th} through April 14^{th} , 2018, as
